“Green Light” Cars

- Most vehicles need less than in **\$1,000** wholesale reconditioning.
- If a vehicle exceeds the reconditioning allowance, price concessions are allowed, subject to buyer approval.

CarOffer™ does not allow for the sale of vehicles with evidence of:

- Structural damage
- Structural repair(s)
- Deployed airbag(s)
- Voided manufacturer’s warranty
- Altered or inoperable odometer
- Branded or bonded title
- Excessive reconditioning costs as determined by CarOffer™ authorized personnel (e.g. major drivetrain concerns, extensive cosmetic, perforated rust, mechanical, or other repairs needed)

Carfax / AutoCheck Reports:

- Vehicles with reports of the following are not permitted:
 - Major accident(s)
 - Major damage
 - Defined as **“Moderate to Severe”** or **“Severe.”** Moderate damage is permissible.
 - Structural damage / repair(s)
 - Deployed airbag(s)
 - Prior flood damage
 - Odometer inconsistencies
 - Theft report(s)
 - 3+ accidents reported

The following vehicles are subject to buyer approval:

- Vehicles with value-altering aftermarket parts as determined by the buyer.
- Vehicles with an open Safety Recall without a remedy.
- Vehicles that do not meet state inspection / emission standards.
- Vehicles with dashboard warning lights are subject to seller diagnosis and buyer acceptance.
